CANDIDATURES A LA PRESIDENCE

Résumé et recommandations

Le processus d'appel à candidatures pour la Présidence de CGLU est un exercice mondial qui se fait par le biais d'un appel ouvert à tous les membres.

Le calendrier et l'annonce ont été approuvés par la Commission des affaires statutaires lors du Conseil mondial de 2021. L'appel a été annoncé en mars 2022 et diffusé parmi les membres de CGLU par e-mail. Les candidatures devaient être soumises avant le 1er août 2022.

Il y a actuellement quatre candidat·e·s au poste de Président·e de CGLU.

La Commission des affaires statutaires est invitée à :

LES REGLES STATUTAIRES

1. En vertu de l'article 58 des Statuts, la Présidence, comprenant le/la Président·e et jusqu'à cinq Coprésident·e·s, est élue par le Conseil mondial parmi ses membres gouvernements locaux. La Présidence inclura également le/la Président·e de la Commission permanente pour l'égalité des genres, en tant que membre *ex officio* disposant de pleins droits, au cas où l'équilibre des genres ne serait pas atteint.
2. Selon l'article 59, les candidatures pour le/la Président·e et les Coprésident·e·s peuvent être présentées par : a) le Bureau exécutif ; ou b) au moins six membres « gouvernements locaux » de pays différents et d'au moins deux régions mondiales différentes (en plus de leur propre région). Le soutien doit venir de membres des différentes régions du monde, mais pas nécessairement d'une section même.
3. Malgré le caractère mondial du mandat, il est traditionnellement considéré que le collège présidentiel de l'Organisation mondiale sera plus viable s'il est intégré par des membres provenant de différentes sections et représentant la grande diversité de l'Organisation.
4. Traditionnellement, les candidatures à la Présidence sont présentées sous forme de ticket. En raison de la nature large et hétérogène du collège présidentiel, cette formule a permis aux membres du Conseil mondial d'avoir la garantie que ses membres travailleraient ensemble et accompliraient leur tâche efficacement. Ce point est particulièrement pertinent, au vu du grand nombre de candidat·e·s.
