CANDIDATURAS A LA PRESIDENCIA

Resumen y recomendaciones

El proceso de presentación de candidaturas a la Presidencia de CGLU es un ejercicio global que se lleva a cabo mediante un envío masivo a todos los miembros.

La Comisión de Asuntos Estatutarios acordó el calendario y el anuncio durante el Consejo Mundial de 2021. La convocatoria se anunció en marzo de 2022 y se divulgó entre los miembros de CGLU por correo electrónico. Las candidaturas debían presentarse antes del 1 de agosto de 2022.

Actualmente existen cuatro candidaturas para el cargo de Presidente/a de CGLU.

LAS NORMAS ESTATUTARIAS

1. Según lo previsto en el artículo 58 de la Constitución, la Presidencia, en la que se incluyen el Presidente y hasta 5 Copresidentes, es elegida por el Consejo Mundial entre los miembros de gobiernos locales. *La Presidencia también incluye a la Presidenta de la Comisión Permanente de Igualdad de Género como miembro ex officio* de pleno derecho en el caso de que no se alcance la cuota de género.
2. De acuerdo con el artículo 59, las candidaturas para el Presidente y los Co-Presidentes pueden ser presentadas por: a) el Bureau Ejecutivo; o b) al menos seis miembros de Gobiernos Locales de países diferentes y al menos de dos regiones mundiales distintas (además de la propia). Los apoyos de los miembros deben buscarse en las diferentes regiones mundiales, pero no de una Sección *per se*.
3. A pesar del carácter global del mandato, se sobreentiende que una presidencia colegiada es más sostenible si la integran miembros provenientes de diferentes Secciones y representan la amplia diversidad de la Organización.
4. Tradicionalmente las candidaturas a la Presidencia se han venido presentando en forma de candidatura única. Debido al carácter amplio y heterogéneo del colegio presidencial, esta fórmula ha permitido a los miembros del Consejo Mundial evaluar su capacidad de trabajar en conjunto y llevar a cabo sus responsabilidades. Esto es importante en el caso actual de un número elevado de candidaturas.
